The Buckeye Central Board of Education held their regular monthly meeting on Tuesday, June 28, 2016, at 7:00 p.m. in the Multi-Purpose Room at Buckeye Central Local School.

Board Committee Reports:

- Financial – Mrs. McDougal and Mrs. Ackerman met this month to review the district finances prior to the board meeting. Mrs. McDougal reported that the projected budget versus actual expenditures and revenue continues to run positively on behalf of the district.
- Legislative - Mr. Martin shared that legislation related to door barricades within schools is being reviewed in Columbus. Understanding any potential legislation regarding this topic is important within districts safety and security planning.

- Policy – Mrs. Diesch and Mr. Heydinger shared that the agenda included the final reading of several pieces of district policy. Upon passage, these individual policies will become a component of district policy. The specific policies submitted for approval can be found within the agenda.

Superintendent's Report and Discussions:

- Mr. Robinson and Andrew Welch, Architect, reviewed the Criteria Architect Proposal from Thomas Porter Architects with the Board members. Quality discussion regarding the proposed contract, process, and timelines took place. The collaboration allowed the Board members and

administration to gain a full understanding of the design services. The agenda included a resolution to approve the Criteria Architect for Design Build Proposal which was approved.

- Mr. Robinson discussed the possible implementation of a student drug/alcohol testing program with the Board members. Presently, Buckeye Central is the only Crawford County district that does not utilize a testing program for the students. Any such implementation would be for the benefit of the students; encouraging them to live healthy and drug-free lives. The Board directed Mr. Robinson to continue researching this topic with further updates to be given at future Board meetings.
