- Mr. Robinson shared the Mid-Ohio ESC All-Boards Appreciation Dinner invitation with the board members. The board members and administration discussed who would be attending. Mr. Robinson will contact the ESC regarding the RSVP's.

Board Committee Reports:

- Financial – Mrs. Aichholz and Mrs. Ackerman met prior to the meeting to review the monthly financials. The forecast and actuals remain close and on track.
- Legislative – No report
- Student Achievement – Mrs. Diesch provided the student achievement report. She highlighted notable achievements that require collaboration and serve as an extension of the classroom. During “Right to Read” Week the students will benefit from a visiting author and illustrator. Literacy Night is scheduled for the evening of November 15. Leadership achievement was characterized through the recent National Honor Society (NHS) Induction. Student Council hosted a Veteran’s Day Assembly on Friday, November 4. The high school students initiated a flag retirement project that was introduced at the assembly and the 4th grade students participated in a flag etiquette program. - OSBA Capital Conference – Mr. Robinson, Mrs. Aichholz, Mrs. Diesch, and Mr. Heydinger, will be attending the OSBA Capital Conference on November 14 & 15. This annual conference provides excellent professional development activities and programs for board members and central office administrators.
- Auxiliary Gymnasium - Mr. Robinson provided an update on the auxiliary gym project. Proposals are due from the selected design-build contractors on December 9. The board established meeting dates on December 13, 14, & 15 to meet with the contractors and review their respective proposals.

- Signs of Suicide Program (SOS) – Mr. Robinson shared the details of the SOS program which includes a Community Forum/Meeting at 7:00 p.m. on November 16. Teachers will share the curriculum materials with the students in early December. Realizing that some parents may consider this a sensitive topic, Mr. Robinson shared that an “opt-out” form will be provided to parents.
