Safety Measures Being Implemented [RE: COVID-19]

- Classrooms and buses will be cleaned and sanitized on a regular (daily) basis.
- Every attempt will be made to social distance students at least 3 feet apart in classroom areas.
- Masks will be provided upon request. (Both in the buildings and on the buses.)
- Hand sanitizing stations located throughout the building.
- Ongoing communication to parents/community via social media and the district website – buckeye-central.org.
- Full-time nurse to evaluate students and communicate with parents.
- Ongoing dialogue with Crawford County Public Health.
- Students assigned to one bus. (Same as last year)
- Curbside drop-off and pick-up for students. (Same as last year)
- Social distancing continued during lunch periods.

Parents are encouraged to keep their student(s) home when feeling ill.

Individuals 12 years and older are currently eligible for the COVID-19 vaccination.
